#### Goal:

- -7<sup>th</sup> grade will increase from 36% passing rate 45% passing rate on the SBA. We will use iReady and Classroom based assessments for progress monitoring.
- -6<sup>th</sup> grade will increase from 22% passing rate to 40% passing rate on the SBA. We will use iReady and Classroom based assessments for progress monitoring.
